**Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities  
(Public Authorities) (Interim) Regulations 2007**

**1 Objective**

The objective of these Regulations is to declare certain entities not to be public authorities for the purposes of the Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities.

**2 Authorising provision**

These Regulations are made under section 46 of the Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities.

**3 Commencement**

These Regulations come into operation on 1 January 2008.

#### 4 Public authorities

Each of the following entities is declared not to be a public authority for the purposes of the Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities—

- (a) the Adult Parole Board established by section 61 of the **Corrections Act 1986**;
- (b) the Youth Residential Board continued in existence by section 431 of the **Children, Youth and Families Act 2005**;
- (c) the Youth Parole Board continued in existence by section 442 of the **Children, Youth and Families Act 2005**.

#### 5 Expiry

These Regulations expire on 31 December 2008.
